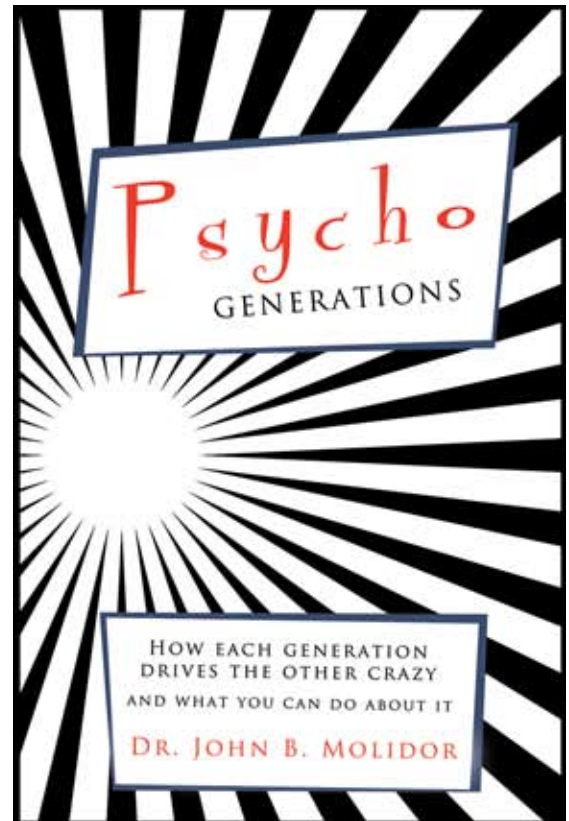
The book is both meaningful and fun, and is chock full of stories, anecdotes, and first person comments from each "psycho" generation!
